DISTANCE EDUCATION STUDY CENTRES

The core purpose of the study centers is to provide extended services associated with education and training by adhering to standards, which are reviewed continuously for improvement to accomplish consistent stakeholder satisfaction. The Institution has signed MOUs with Mother Teresa Women's University (MTWU), Tamilnadu Physical Education and Sports University (TNPESU) and University of Madras (UNOM) for offering their distance education courses. More than 100 courses were offered through distance education.

BANK TRAINING


