Eminent members of the teaching and non-teaching fraternity, Members of the press, well wishers of the college and Beloved students Today is a proud moment for everyone, as the college crosses the threshold to step into the 25th year of excellence. At this happy moment, I am elated to present the 24th Annual Report to this august gathering.

As the College enters the 25th year of its existence, we must salute the foresight of our founders, who understood the significance of higher education for women. Deep down, they realized the importance of moving a step at a time, and therefore started so modestly in 1994. That modest beginning has now brought us to this august day.

MKJC is focusing on educational activity from teaching to learn; skills to think, content to process and teacher instruction to student demonstration.

MKJC is Re-accredited with 'A' grade by NAAC with a CGPA of 3.27 in a Four point scale. A self study report for 3rd cycle of NAAC accreditation was submitted on 15th February 2019 and we are waiting for NAAC peer team visit. Our college is an ISO 9001:2015 Certified institution and affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University. NIRF has been submitted for National Ranking. 12(B) and 2(f) has also been submitted. AICTE extension of approval has been received. The institution has obtained permanent affiliation status from the academic year 2018-19. The college has been shortlisted by Anuragam Publications for the award of Best governing college. The college is awarded with IAB Blind Empowerment Championships-2019 in recognition of Voluntary contribution for the Empowerment of Visual Challenges by Indian Association for the Blind, Madurai.

At present our college offers 15 UG, 11 PG, 6 M.Phil-Research, 1 Ph.D Programme (Full Time/Part Time). With all the experience from producing thousands of graduates, backed by 164 teaching staff and 51 non-teaching staff, the college is emerging as a premier Institute. A good number of faculty members have passed NET/SET Qualifying Examination. More number of faculties is with M.Phil and Ph.D. Our college student and staff Ratio is 16:1.

The College has introduced BA (Tamil), MBA (HRM) and M.Phil (Bio-Tech) taking in view of the exponential growth witnessed in the field of cultural literature studies Business Studies, Life Science in the recent decades. Commerce and Bio-Tech Department has got additional section of existing course for this academic year.

The College will introduce B.Sc (Physical Education), B.Sc (Psychology), BSW, B.Sc (Vis Com), MBA (MMM), M.Phil (Physics) and Ph.D (Bio-Tech) in order to mount up the courses for the development of the institution and to foster and expertise the students in the field of sports and games, application of knowledge, society upliftment, Analyze the effective communication, to master in Business Studies, software production and to enrich the scientific research ability.

ACCOMPLISHMENT IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-19:

INFRASTRUCTURE / AMENITIES ADDED:

- New audio visual technical lab has been introduced for the purpose of e-learning.
- Internet bandwidth has been upgraded to 11 Mbps from 8 Mbps & a new additional network of 200 Mbps is available. Wi-Fi is available in both the blocks.
- NPTEL local chapter is established and more than 50 students have registered.
- An elevator facility is provided for the students, staff members as well as differently abled students.
- Advanced Instruments worth 8 lakhs has been provided to the Department of Bio technology for M.Phil & forthcoming Ph.D programme.
- Chemicals and instruments worth 5, 30,000 have been provided for the Department of Chemistry.
- An additional floor is constructed in new block.
- 38 CC TV cameras have been installed in the college campus to tighten up the security.
- To improve the transport facilities 6 new buses were bought and activated with new bus routes.
- Additional Solar Plant worth 10.75 lakhs with 20KW has been installed.
- R.O Plant of worth 3.5 lakhs has been replaced for both the blocks.
