Summary

The NCC Enrollment Programme was successfully held on 24th July 2025 at 10:00 AM at the MKJC Campus, with the primary objective of enrolling first-year students into the National Cadet Corps (NCC) and inspiring them towards a life rooted in discipline, leadership, and national service.

The event was graced by the esteemed presence of officers from the 10 TN Battalion NCC, Vellore, including Lt. Col. Venkatesh, Commanding Officer; Subedar Rajesh K. M.; Naik Subedar Binu T.; and Ms. Akshaya S., Girl Cadet Instructor.

The dignitaries delivered motivational speeches, highlighting the core values of the NCC, the importance of accountability, and the vast opportunities that cadetship offers, leaving a profound impact on the participants.

Among the 54 students who took part in the enrollment process, 29 qualified and were formally enrolled as cadets after completing eligibility checks and a basic physical fitness test, while 8 students were kept on a reservation list for future consideration.

The programme witnessed enthusiastic student participation and was marked by the seamless coordination of NCC Officers, Institutional Coordinators, and Faculty Members, whose collective efforts ensured the smooth conduct and resounding success of the event.

Outcome of the Programme


