## Project 2

Seed money of Rs. 6,335/- received for the Research Project titled “Impact of Flax Seed and Black Seed on Body Weight and Body Composition in Healthy Obese Women”. PG Department of Foods and Nutrition, carried out the Research work from December 2021 to January 2022. The study was conducted among 25 healthy obese Women aged from 20 to 45 years with BMI 27 - 30 kg/m<sup>2</sup>. The selected subjects were supplemented with 50 gms of value-added balls developed from flax seed and black seed for the period of 45 days. During this supplementary period, the subjects were strictly advised to follow a balanced diet with a regular exercise regime. The subjects were analyzed for anthropometric measurements such as height, weight, BMI and WHR before and after supplementation. Dietary patterns were also collected from the study samples. The developed value-added balls were examined for its nutritive value and shelf life. There was a reduction in body weight, BMI and WC on using the value-added balls.
