Summary

The NSS, YRC and PG Department of Psychology, School of Life Sciences of Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), in association with Aram Samuga Munetra Sangam, Thumberi, proposed extension and outreach activity and organized an awareness programme on 'Psychological effects of transitioning to high school' on 06.09.2024 at Government Higher Secondary School, Thumberi between 01.30 p.m - 03.30 p.m for the higher secondary second year students of the school. The program began with an invocation to Mother Tamil.

Dr. P. Balasubramanian, Research Coordinator and Assistant Professor of the PG and Research Department of Tamil of Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi addressed the school students with his motivational talk. He insisted the students to follow the right path in life, to concentrate in studies and become the good citizens of the Nation. The students of Psychology then performed their skit titled 'Whispers of the future'. They depicted on how to lead a life by example and how the young generation falls prey to unwanted and untoward situations at an early stage of life. Mime show was then showcased by the students of Psychology under the title 'Unspoken Consequences', where they depicted how young boys get addicted to mobile games, drugs, alcohol and the ways to overcome them. They also stressed not to waste food, water and how to be cordial among the friends and family members through their performance.

Ms. Daniya Mariyam T of III B.Sc Psychology, gave an English speech highlighting the importance of discipline and a cultured way of life for both the boys and girls of the school. The students of Psychology then conducted few activities for the school students like expressing gratitude, problem solving and decision making, inorder to motivate the students and help them think better.

The school students found the awareness programme to be very useful and meaningful and they registered their valuable feedbacks about the programme. Ms. S.Aruna, NSS Coordinator, then thanked the Head Master and other teachers of the school for the opportunity given to conduct an extension activity at their school. The program came to an end by singing the National Anthem.
