REPORT

On 21st September, 2023, A One Day Awareness Programme on Suicide Prevention was jointly organized at Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women, Vaniyambadi by The Department of Psychology & District Mental Health Programme, Tirupattur District to commemorate World Suicide Prevention Day. The program was presided by the honorable chief guest Thiru. D.
