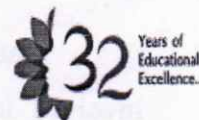

Summary

The College Union and Fine Arts Association celebrated Golu from 22.09.2025 to 30.09.2025 at Swami Vivekananda Auditorium. Golu is a traditional festival in South India, where dolls and figurines are displayed during the autumn season, especially during the Navaratri festival. These displays are often themed, telling stories from Hindu mythology, or showing scenes like weddings, everyday life, and even miniature kitchen setups. This festival is also called Kolu, Gombe Habba, Bommai Golu, or Bommala Koluvu.

Throughout the 9 days, each department participated in the Golu celebrations with various activities, such as Singing devotional songs, classical dance performances and narrating epic stories. The students of MKJC wore traditional clothes to mark the occasion and add to the festive atmosphere.


Staff members, including both teaching and non-teaching staff, were also actively involved in the celebrations. During the event, traditional prasadam (sacred food) was distributed to all participants. A total of 3,150 students and staff participated in the celebration, making it a joyous and successful event.

Outcome of the Programme
