

It aims at giving students a true vision of life to help them face challenges in a positive and dynamic manner and heartily contribute to society. The student is the focal point of the program. The program also embraces all the stakeholders the management, teachers and parents. Through them, the club's vision spreads to the society, country and the world at large.





NOW THIS MOU WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: Objective

- 1. To set up the Blu hornbill storytelling Club at the College.
- 2. To Establish collaborative partnerships to conduct training programs both online and offline.
- 3. To Foster mutual interdisciplinary research at national and international levels to support children, adolescents, and stakeholders.
- 4. To Facilitate academic and practical exchanges to promote the sharing of knowledge and experiences, encouraging innovation and collaboration
- **5.** To Organize workshops and conferences to support the learning and development process of the community.
- 6. To Promote faculty and staff exchanges between organizations and facilitate technical collaboration to enhance knowledge sharing, capacity building, and innovation.

Article 2: Areas of Cooperation

The parties agree to collaborate in setting-up the 'Blu Hornbill Club' at the college and through the club work on the following areas:

- 1. **Training Programs:** Development of collaborative partnerships to design and deliver training programs through online and offline platforms.
- 2. Interdisciplinary Research: Engagement in research initiatives at national and international levels to address the needs of children, adolescents, and stakeholders.
- 3. **Knowledge and Experience Sharing:** Facilitation of academic and practical exchanges to promote knowledge sharing, innovation, and collaboration in education and community development.
- Workshops and Conferences: Organization of workshops, conferences, and seminars to support the learning and development processes within the community.
- Faculty and Staff Exchanges: Implementing exchange programs and technical collaborations to enhance knowledge sharing, capacity building, and innovative practices.



Article 3: Implementation

3.1 Formation of a Coordination Committee

A Coordination Committee, comprising representatives from both parties, will be established to:

- 1. Formalize the partnership through the signing of the MoU.
- 2. Develop a detailed action plan within 15 -20 days of signing the MoU.

3.2 Key Responsibilities and Commitments

The Coordination Committee, comprising representatives from both ACENOVATION and CAAF INDIA, will be responsible for communicating information, planning and implementing the projects.

Article 4: Financial Arrangements

Both parties agree that this MoU does not impose any financial obligation unless specified in separate agreements. Any costs incurred for joint activities will be borne by (specific party) or shared equally by both parties, subject to prior approval.

Article 5: Duration and Review

- 1. This MoU is valid for Five years from the date of signing.
- 2. A review of progress will be conducted annually to evaluate the outcomes and update objectives as needed.

Article 6: Termination

6.1 Termination Notice: Either Party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) by providing a minimum of NINETY (90) days written notice to the other Party. The termination shall take effect on the date specified in the notice or the completion of the 90-day notice period, whichever is later.



- 6.2 Ongoing Activities: Any activities in progress at the time of termination shall be allowed to proceed to completion as per the agreed-upon schedule unless both Parties mutually decide otherwise.
- 6.3 Mutual Termination Agreement: The MoU may also be terminated at any time through mutual written agreement by both Parties, specifying the effective date of termination in the agreement.
- 6.4 Obligations Post-Termination: Both Parties shall ensure the settlement of any outstanding obligations or responsibilities related to the MoU before the termination's effective date.
- 6.5 Confidentiality Post-Termination: The termination of this MoU does not relieve either Party of its confidentiality obligations or any other responsibilities explicitly mentioned in this agreement, which are intended to survive termination.
- 6.6 Transition Plan: In the event of termination, the Parties will work collaboratively to develop a transition plan to minimize disruption to ongoing activities and stakeholders, ensuring its implementation by the effective termination date.
- 6.7 Non-Prejudicial Termination: Termination of this MoU shall not prejudice any legal rights or remedies that either Party may have accrued up to the effective date of termination.

Article 7: General Provisions and Notices

- 7.1.1 Communication: All communications under this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) shall be made in writing and the English language.
- 7.1.2 Communications shall be delivered by registered mail, electronic mail, or facsimile to the respective addresses or contact details of MarudharKesari College for Women or ACENOVATION as provided below, or to any updated address, email, or facsimile number officially notified by either Party.
- 7.1.3 Communications shall be deemed duly delivered and acknowledged upon receipt by the intended recipient.
- 7.2 Non-Legally Binding Nature: This MoU is not legally binding but serves as a statement of intent to promote cooperation and collaboration between the Parties.







7.3 Dispute Resolution: Any disputes or disagreements arising from the MoU shall be resolved amicably through discussions and mutual agreement between the Parties.

7.4 Notification of Changes: Either Party may update its contact details or communication preferences by providing written notice to the other Party.
