The first Governing Council meeting was held on June 15, 2024, at 11:00 AM in the New Seminar Hall and began with a prayer song. The Chairman & Principal of the college Dr.M.Inbavalli introduced each member, welcomed the Honourable Secretary Anand Singhvi, emphasizing the pivotal role of the management's support in the college's success and highlighted the significance of this inaugural meeting.

She praised the faculty's hard work and congratulated all stakeholders of MKJC for achieving autonomous status. Additionally, she commended the members for securing 102

university ranks and 10 gold medals in the 2023 TVU Examinations. The Chairman then provided an overview of MKJC, explaining the history of the college and its vision and mission. Following this, the agenda of the meeting was taken up for discussion.

Agenda 3: To ratify UG and PG Regulations and Examinations Schemes (Approved by First Governing Body)

The Controller of Examinations, Dr. T. Balasubramanian, gave a summary of the UG and PG Regulations and Examination Schemes for the students admitted from the AY 2024-2025. The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), which gives students freedom and a multidisciplinary approach to education, was highlighted by him. Additionally, he highlighted the Learning Outcome-based Education (LOBE) framework, which strives to accomplish particular learning objectives across a range of academic programs.

He emphasized the release of an innovative self-study paper that offers two credits and assists students in developing their critical thinking skills as well as unrestricted learning freedom. He further emphasized that PG programs demand 92 credits, while UG programs require 141+2 credits overall. To ensure a thorough assessment of students' academic achievement, the examination scheme incorporates both internal assessments and end-of-semester exams. Moreover, the policy for library usage supports extensive academic research and resource accessibility for all students and requested the academic council to ratify the following UG and PG Regulations and Examinations Schemes to be from the Academic Year 2024-25.

Resolution: The Council members approved the regulations with a few suggestions. They recommended changing the Self-Learning Course assessment to be 100% based on external marks, thereby eliminating internal marks. Further they highlighted that for the Projects: modify the assessment and allocate 25 marks for internal evaluation and 75 marks for external evaluation, with 50 marks for the project and 25 marks for the viva-voce.

The Principal shared to the honourable members that, due to unforeseen circumstances, student enrolment for the B.A. in Urdu program has been stopped for this Academic Year.




