Topic/ Subject of the Activity

Orientation on Training & Placement

Objectives (Input)

- To orient III UG and II PG students on the Training and Placement Programme for the academic year 2026–2027.
- To familiarize students with the placement process, eligibility criteria, and recruitment procedures.
- To create awareness about employability skills, career planning, and industry expectations.
- To motivate students to actively participate in placement training, internships, certification programmes, and campus recruitment drives.

Methodology (Process)

The Placement and Career Guidance Cell organized a five-day Orientation on Training & Placement from 15.06.2026 to 19.06.2026 at Sri Roop Rajat Seminar Hall. The orientation programme was conducted by Dr. H. Lookman Sithic, Vice Principal and Director, Skill Development Centre, for 736 III UG and II PG students across five sessions.

During the sessions, Dr. H. Lookman Sithic introduced students to the Training and Placement Programme for the academic year 2026–2027. He explained how students could enhance their employability through aptitude training, soft skills development, communication skills, and other placement-oriented training programmes. Students were informed about the internal and external training programmes, certification opportunities, internships, the placement registration process, eligibility criteria, recruitment procedures, and industry expectations. The orientation motivated students to actively participate in the various training initiatives and placement drives organized by the Placement and Career Guidance Cell throughout the academic year.

The programme aligns with SDG 4 – Quality Education, Target 4.4, which aims to substantially increase the number of youth with relevant technical and vocational skills for employment, decent jobs, and entrepreneurship. It also supports SDG 8 – Decent Work and Economic Growth, Target 8.6, which

seeks to substantially reduce the proportion of youth not in employment, education, or training by preparing students for productive employment through structured career guidance and placement training.

Output

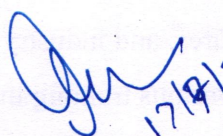
- A total of 736 III UG and II PG students were oriented on the Training and Placement Programme for the academic year 2026–2027.

- Students understood the importance of aptitude training, soft skills, communication skills, and professional development for enhancing employability.

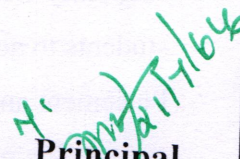
Students were informed about the internal and external training programmes, certification courses, internships, and placement support initiatives offered by the institution, encouraging them to make effective use of these opportunities
