

Summary Report

The session began with a brief introduction about the various research fundings received by the resource person Dr. G. Archunan. He walked the audience through the hardships he endured and the efforts laid behind his success story. The exemplification of the line of events from rejection to acceptance emoted a sense of pride among the participants. The resource person then gave a broader view on the critical aspects in research proposal writing and insisted on finding a strong basis for birthing a novel and cutting-edge research proposal that supports community, health and environment. Through his lecture he outlined the phases of developing a proposal right from the conception of idea till establishing the project outcomes. In continuation, he provided the audience with insights into the evaluation process by experts and the possible cliches that could lead to rejection of the proposal. In addition he also educated the participants on the mertitorious aspects

of a project that could fetch credits for a proposal for example, a concept that is the need-of-the-hour, valid budget, applicability, feasibility of the project, resources required etc. The post break session by the resource person was exploratory involving an in-depth knowledge transfer of the highly interconnected individual components of a research proposal. As a final touch to this insightful seminar, the resource person listed out the various funding agencies in India and the core domains of research to which they fund. The program ended with a Q&A session, where the resource person addressed intellectually to all the queries raised by the participants.

Feedback report

About 90% of the participants reported that the session was very informative and has enhanced their understanding on research proposal writing. They have also recorded that they had obtained a clarity on the important elements in a research proposal namely research design, methodology, budget preparation, defining problem statement, deciphering the outcomes, justifying the significance of the study etc. The participants reported that the seminar was motivating and are now eager and determined to write research proposals that meet the standards and equirements of funding agencies. However the participants have also suggested that the seminar could be made more comprehensive that address the research gap of all science and non-science disciplines. Overall the participants were very satisfied with the session.
