Summary Report

1. Introductory Session

The Ivan Pavlov Association of the PG Department of Psychology, School of Life Sciences, in association with MKJC Alumni Connect of Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women (Autonomous), organized an Alumni Seminar on "The Role of Psychology in Education" on 19th December 2025. The programme was designed to provide students with practical insights into the application of psychological principles in educational settings, while also strengthening alumni–student interaction. The seminar emphasized the relevance of psychology in understanding learners' behaviour, emotional needs, and cognitive processes within modern educational systems.

2. Programme Details

The programme commenced with a prayer, invoking blessings for the successful conduct of the seminar, followed by a warm welcome address. The Associate Dean of Research, Dr. R. Jesu Jaya Sudan Sir addressed the gathering and highlighted the significance of alumni contributions and the importance of developing professional competence and ethical responsibility as future psychologists.

The alumni resource person Ms. Hema, delivered an engaging and insightful talk on the role of Psychology in education. She shared her professional experiences as a Behaviour Therapist working with neurodivergent children and elaborated on how psychological principles guide effective teaching, learning, and behavioural management.

The session began with an ice-breaker activity titled "Why behind the What", encouraging students to reflect on their best teachers and analyze what made them effective—not

just in terms of subject knowledge, but emotional connection and understanding of students. This activity set the tone for an interactive and reflective learning environment.

Ms. Hema explained key psychological concepts such as cognitive psychology, developmental psychology, behaviourism, learning theories, and their relevance in educational contexts. She discussed the importance of inclusive education, Individualized Education Plans (IEPs), and the role of assessments in identifying learning needs.

Real-life case illustrations were shared to help students understand classroom challenges such as attention difficulties, emotional regulation, motivation, and learning differences. The session concluded with an interactive discussion, where students actively participated and clarified their doubts.

Conclusion

The Alumni Seminar on "The Role of Psychology in Education" was highly informative and enriching. The session successfully bridged theoretical knowledge with practical application, inspiring students to view education through a psychological lens. The interaction with the alumna resource person provided valuable professional insight and strengthened the bond between alumni and the institution.

- 1. Students gained clear understanding of substance abuse and its psychological effects.
- 2. The students learnt about proper menstrual hygiene practices and lifestyle adjustments.
