ANTI - RAGGING POLICY

INTRODUCTION

College Campus is a place to find valuable friendship and to cherish unforgettable moments. Marudhar Kesari Jain College for Women strongly condemn any kind of ragging practices. Ragging is a disturbing reality in the higher education system. This policy envisages to curb the act of ragging in any form in the campus and its premises.

OBJECTIVES:

The objective of this policy is

- To prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging in our campus and its premises.
- Maintain a ragging-free, promoting awareness and fostering a student-friendly atmosphere.
- Educate students on the dehumanizing impact of ragging and its inherent perversity.
- Maintain continuous vigilance to prevent and deter ragging incidents.
- To create awareness among the student-teachers about consequences of ragging
- To address any ragging issues immediately and taken action as advised by the committee is the main aim.

SCOPE

- To address any form of campus indiscipline, including teasing, rudeness, or threats, and actions disrupting regular academic and extracurricular activities, a remedy is sought.

RAGGING CONSTITUTES ONE OR MORE OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Indulging in undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- Any act by a student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.

- Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

PROCEDURE:

The Anti-Ragging Committee will assess each incident thoroughly, considering its severity and impact. Based on their evaluation, appropriate punishment will be recommended, which may include:

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges, reflecting the seriousness of the offense.
2. Withholding or withdrawing scholarships, fellowships, and other benefits to deter future misconduct.
3. Prohibition from participating in tests, examinations, or other evaluation processes as a consequence of their actions.
4. Withholding of academic results until disciplinary proceedings are concluded.
5. Exclusion from representing the institution in regional, national, or international events, recognizing the need for accountability.
6. Hostel suspension or expulsion to maintain the safety and well-being of other students.
7. Cancellation of admission, particularly in cases where the misconduct severely undermines the institution's values.

8. Rustication from the institution for a specified period, allowing time for reflection and rehabilitation.
9. Expulsion from the institution and barring from admission elsewhere as a last resort for repeat offenders or severe infractions.
10. Collective punishment may be imposed if the perpetrators remain unidentified, emphasizing the collective responsibility of the student body to prevent ragging.
