PROCEDURE TO GET FINANCIAL BENEFIT FROM THE COLLEGE

To provide financial Assistance, following a standardized procedure to be followed

- Students seeking this support must submit prescribed forms/ Requisition Letters to the department head or college administrative office.
- The department Head evaluates applications based on academic performance and Socio-economic status and forwarded to the principal.
- The principal forwarded the recommendations to the Management for final approval or rejection.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

- Raise awareness among students about various scholarship schemes offered by the College, State government, Central government, and NGOs.
- Convey the scholarship opening and closing date and ensure all eligible students submitted the Applications
- Assist students in completing scholarship application forms.
- Scrutinize scholarship applications with all supporting documents and ensure timely submission/processing to the respective departments.
- Collect and review student applications in time, forwarded to the principal for recommendation and approval.
- Upload scholarship data on various web portals and take necessary follow-ups.
- Maintain the records for auditing and compliances.



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- Manage the Scholarship portal with highest confidentiality.

SCHOLARSHIP APPROVAL

- The value of scholarship awards and the number of recipients in each category will be determined based on available funds, the number of applicants, and the overall merit of applications.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified through official communication from the college.
- The notification will include details about the scholarship amount, terms, and conditions.

SCHOLARSHIP DISBURSEMENT

- Scholarship will be disbursed according to the terms and conditions outlined in the notification.

RENEWAL AND CONTINUATION

- Scholarships may be renewable for subsequent years based on maintaining the required academic and/or performance standards.
- Recipients will be informed about the renewal process and any additional requirements for continued eligibility.

CONDITIONS FOR TERMINATION OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The award may be terminated at any given point in time, if it is found that the candidate has furnished incorrect details/particulars in their application, or is found guilty of malpractice, misconduct, and violation of college policies, rules and regulations.



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TRANSPARENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY
